Manual (stick shift) or automatic car (I've tried to write this so that it is clear whether you drive on the left or the right!) Driving a manual car (stick shift) involves using both legs. Therefore it really doesn't matter which leg was operated on. You can't drive until the leg can do its job properly.

P1 licence holders who passed their driving test in an automatic vehicle (including vehicles with an automatic clutch actuator) will be restricted to driving automatics. This condition remains until you are issued with a provisional P2 or unrestricted licence. To remove the condition earlier, you must pass a driving test in a manual vehicle.

CDL restrictions severely limit your career potential. Per the FMCSA, if you test on an automatic-equipped vehicle, you get a restriction on your license that prohibits you from driving a truck with a manual transmission: (c) Manual transmission. (1) If an applicant performs the skills test in a vehicle equipped with an automatic transmission, the State must indicate on the CDL, if issued, that the person is restricted from operating a CMV equipped with a manual transmission.
