An immediate echocardiogram at the bedside in the emergency room makes it possible to visualise dilatation of the heart chambers, diffuse or regional abnormalities in contraction, functional mitral and/or tricuspid regurgitation or, in contrast, normal LV volume, enlarged left atrium, LV hypertrophy and preserved ejection fraction.
