Dispensationalism is a theological system that recognizes these ages ordained by God to order the affairs of the world. One of the primary reasons why there is such sizable ignorance about the historical origins of Dispensationalism is due to the tendency of Christians to conflate Chiliasm (“ historic Premillennialism ”) with Dispensational Premillennialism. There are several explicit examples of this error that can be recounted.

An Overview of Dispensationalism ' s Historical Origins

Historic Premillennialism (e.g. in George Eldon Ladd) rejects pre-tribulationism, dispensationalism's radical tenets, and its uniquely Jewish view of the 1000 year millennium. John Nelson Darby (1800–1882) introduced dispensationalism as a theological system, which bears several key characteristics, including an insistence upon a “ literal ” hermeneutic or “ plain reading ” of the biblical text in addition to separate divine purposes for Israel and the church.
